World Health Organisation has issued a global alert on
Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS)

If you have flu-like symptoms such as fever, muscle ache,
headache and sore throat you should see a doctor.

If you have high fever and difficulty in breathing, you should immediately
go to hospital for necessary treatment and present this card.

Initially, the affected areas were Guangdong province of China,
Hong Kong and Hanoi (Vietnam) but now cases are
being reported in many other countries.
