SARS

SEVERE ACUTE RESPIRATORY SYNDROME

SARS is a contagious disease spread through close contact with cases of SARS

(history of having cared for, having lived with, having had face to face contact with or having contact with respiratory secretions of an infected person)

If you have..

- high fever ($>38^{\circ}\text{C}$ or $>100.4^{\circ}\text{F}$) within 10 days after travelling to the affected areas
or
- had close contact with cases of SARS

IMMEDIATELY..

go to a government hospital for the necessary management.
Inform your doctor of your recent travel history

Countries affected with SARS are
China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Vietnam,
Canada (Toronto) and Singapore.
