SARS

SEVERE ACUTE RESPIRATORY SYNDROME

SARS is a contagious disease spread through close contact with cases of SARS

(history of having cared for, having lived with, having had face to face contact with or having contact with respiratory secretions of an infected person)

DO NOT travel to the affected areas for the time being

**Countries affected with SARS are
China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Vietnam,
Canada and Singapore.**

Symptoms of SARS

- High fever ($>38^{\circ}\text{C}$ or $>100.4^{\circ}\text{F}$) within 10 days after travelling to the affected areas
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Headache
- Muscle ache
- Difficulty in breathing or shortness of breath

IMMEDIATELY..

go to a government hospital for the necessary management if you have HIGH FEVER.

Inform your doctor of your recent travel history.
